However, followers of Christ need fresh and specific vision to inspire each segment of the Christ-following journey!

This *Vision Worksheet* is designed to help you clear the cobwebs and focus the vision of your own life, career, family, ministry and impact over the next year!

STARTING POINT:

1. You are currently living out a vision you had in the past! What visions have you previously had that came to pass or you are currently living in?
2. Do you have a clear, concise, focused and easily articulated vision for this year? If so, what is it?
3. Do you find capturing and crafting a vision easy or difficult? Explain!
4. *Visioning* often involves other people! What other people in your life (a friend, relative, mentor, parent, small group leader, pastor, counselor, coach) do you need to involve in the *visioning* process?

IMAGINING:

5. What *next-12-month-challenges* will need to be faced and overcome?

6. What is the current state of your life? You need to define '*where you are*' before you can define '*where you need to go*'!

7. What do you sense would be God's priority or dream for your life? Where is God taking you? What would God consider a 'successful' life for you?

8. It's easy to become trapped by routine, obligation and demands! This is an opportunity to time-travel into the future! If resources, time, permission and energy weren't limiting you, what could you imagine happening in the next 12 months? What would '*an amazing, impacting, life-transforming, mission-boosting future*' look like?

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9. Is there a Bible verse that serves as an inspiration or anchor for your life? What is it?

REFINING:

10. Coming out of the previous questions, has a singular picture, vision or dream-initiative for your life emerged or, more specifically, for the next 12 months? If not, use this space to work-sheet-out some possible sentences or phrases!

TESTING IT:

Write down your vision! (Realize, getting to his point may take 4-8 weeks or more! Be patient but persistent!)

11. Is the vision clear? Can others understand it?
12. Is it challenging? Does it inspire and propel you forward?
13. Is it visual? Does it create mental images of a better future for your life, family, work-place, church or community?
14. Is it future oriented?
15. Is it realistic yet stretching?
16. Does it inspire passion? After hearing it, would someone feel energized?
17. Is there a sense of urgency about the vision?
18. Does this vision align with God's Word and mission?

to become a reality?
